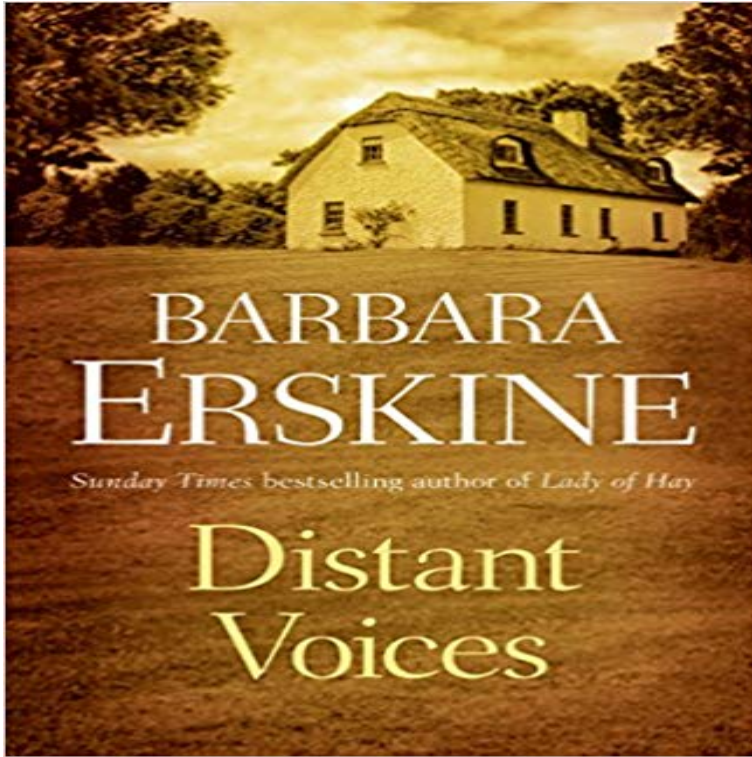


Distant Voices
